

# *Hurricane Supplies Checklist*

## **Essentials**

- ✓
- Fuel car
- First Aid Kit and Book
- Fire Extinguisher
- Water (3 gallons per person per day)
- Water Purification Tablets
- Flashlights
- Battery operated radio and TV
- Plenty of batteries to last for several days
- Extra pair of house and car keys
- Cash, change, credit cards
- Non-electric can opener
- Canned and dried food
- Baby food, diapers, formula
- Extra pet food, water, leash, collar, medication, and carrier
- Medicines and prescriptions
- Sleeping bags, blankets, and pillows

## **Sanitation Supplies**

- ✓
- Soap, shampoo, toiletries
- Feminine hygiene supplies
- Toilet paper and towelettes
- Plastic trash bags (Multiple sizes)
- Trash cans (Multiple sizes)
- Bar soap and liquid detergent
- Toothpaste and toothbrushes
- Household bleach (No additives)
- Tarps and rain ponchos

## **Safety and Comfort**

- ✓
- Heavy, sturdy shoes
- Gloves and goggles
- Change of clothes for everyone in the family
- Cellular phone
- Battery-operated alarm clock
- Glasses or contact lenses
- Important phone numbers
- Insurance Information
- Drivers License
- Valuable papers
- Toys for children and pets
- Candles and matches
- Light sticks
- Knife or razor blades

*Stocking up now on emergency supplies can add to you safety and comfort during and after a hurricane. Store enough supplies for at least 72 hours.*

- Tent
- Communication supplies: paper, envelopes, pens, stamps
- Garden hose for siphoning and firefighting
- Butane lighter
- City map

## **Cooking**

- ✓
- Plastic knives, forks, spoons
- Paper cups, plates, napkins
- Heavy duty aluminum foil
- Portable cooler for water and food
- Cooking utensils
- Emergency cooking facilities (Grill or a camp stove)
- Gas tank for grill (Make sure tank is full)
- Pots and Pans
- Cans, gas, and oil

## **Tools, Clean up & Repair Supplies**

- ✓
- Hurricane shutters or plywood cut and labeled to fit specific windows
- Camera & film to record damage
- Cleaning supplies, disinfectants
- Generators
- Mosquito netting and repellent
- Life preservers
- Lanterns and extra fuels
- Ladders
- Inflatable raft
- Duct tape and masking tape
- Extension cords
- Nails, screws, bolts
- Hammer, hatchet
- Axe, shovel, broom
- Pails and buckets
- Rope
- Wheelbarrow
- Tool kit
- Staple gun
- Adjustable wrench for turning gas off
